



## **Lliswerry Baptist Church Youth worker Opportunity**

To lead and develop the work with the young people at Lliswerry Baptist Church and the community. Being responsible to God's leading with guidance from the minister and deacons.

### **Key responsibilities:**

### **Key tasks:**

Lead a programme which disciples our current young people integrating them with the rest of the church. To encourage participation by young people in the youth work programme, the wider church life and their local community, through youth forum work and other means. To establish and build strong links with youth groups from other churches in the region.
